- APRICOT is the biggest event for APIA

 - AP* meeting, AP IPv6 Task Force, Asia Broadband Summit, APTLD are also hosted alongside APRICOT

APRICOT 2007

- Held in Bali, Indonesia
- Hosted by the Indonesian ISP Association (APJII)
- 570 participants from 50 economies: Breakdown:
 - Tutorials = 280 persons
 - Workshop = 192 persons
 - Conference = 306 persons
 - ID-Stream = 250 persons
 - ID-CEO = 250 persons
 - Speakers = 157 persons

APRICOT 2008

- APRICOT 2008 being held now in Taipei, Taiwan, hosted by TWNIC.
 - Current registration: TBA
 - APRICOT Workshops continue to be popular with 5 workshops ongoing currently
 - Very extensive program of 10 days

APRICOT 2009

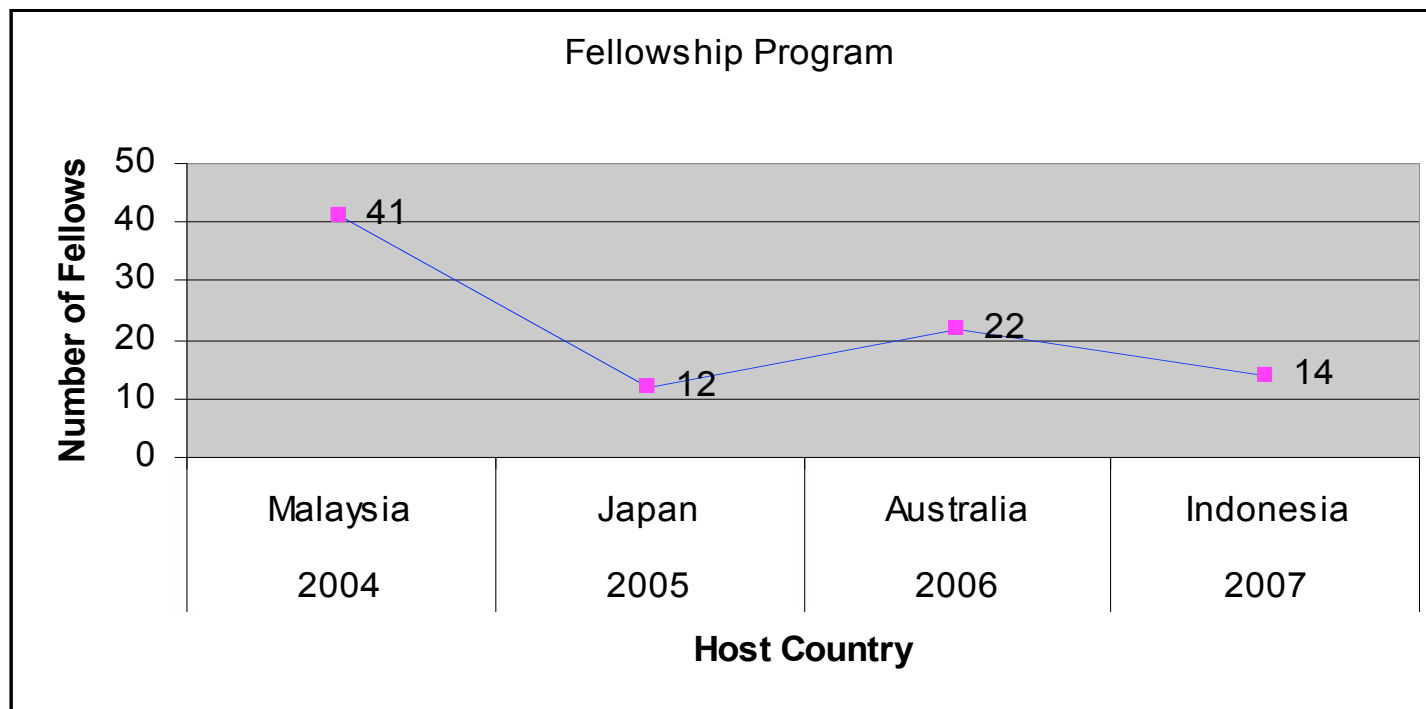
- Will be held in Manila, Philippines
