Secretariat

- Day to day project management responsibility for APRICOT conferences
 - Chairing APRICOT2012 Management Committee
- Operates the APRICOT Fellowship Programme
 - Includes seeking funding & fellowship finances, coordinating the selection process, managing the Fellows housing, programme & reimbursement
 - Guidance from Fellowship Committee Chair, Paul Wilson

Secretariat

- Manages the Administrative Function of the Programme Committee
 - Includes speaker management & administrative support function and supporting the PC
 - Guidance from Programme Committee Chairs, Mark Tinka & Jonny Martin
- Soliciting International Sponsorship and partly managing the sponsors
 - Providing operational assistance to local host by helping to bill and collect from the Sponsors

APIA Activities 2011

- SANOG
 - SANOG 17 was held in Colombo, Sri Lanka in January
 - SANOG 18 was held in Pokhara, Nepal, in September
 - SANOG 19 is part of APRICOT 2012 rather than separate event
 - SANOG is a well known brand name in South Asia

Activities 2011

- APStar
 - APIA contributed US\$5K to APStar in 2011
 - APIA hosted the AP* Meeting in APRICOT 2011
 - APStar's Secretariat based in AIT, Bangkok was affected by the Bangkok Flood.
 - APIA will support APStar to get back on its feet

Activities 2011

- CommunicAsia 2011
 - APIA joined APNIC & DotAsia to participate in CommunicAsia 2011
- Donation
 - APIA donated US\$2K to the JP Red Cross to support their Relief effort

APIA Activities 2011

- MyNOG – Malaysia Network Operators Group
 - APIA provided a seed fund to help MyNOG to establish itself
 - MyNOG 1 was held on 16 Jan 2012. The one day event attracted over 130 delegates
 - MyNOG 2 is likely to see an expansion of activities

APRICOT Update

- APRICOT is the biggest event for APIA
 - Continues to be recognized as the main AP wide event on Internet related technologies
 - APRICOT structure allows the simple co-location of other AP Internet related events
- As from APRICOT 2012, APNIC is co-organiser of APRICOT
 - APNIC has been long term financial and infrastructure supporter

APRICOT Update

- Management Committee
 - Limited to those who are actively involved in the organising of APRICOT
 - Led by Molly Cheam and Ole Jacobsen
 - Held 18 meetings to prepare for APRICOT 2012
- Fellowship Committee
 - Group of volunteers from across the industry
 - Led by Paul Wilson

APRICOT Update

- Programme Committee
 - Open call for volunteers to APOPS and apnic-talk mailing lists
 - Responsible for tutorial and conference session content
 - Led by Mark Tinka and Jonny Martin
 - Held 10 meetings to prepare programme for APRICOT 2012

APRICOT 2011

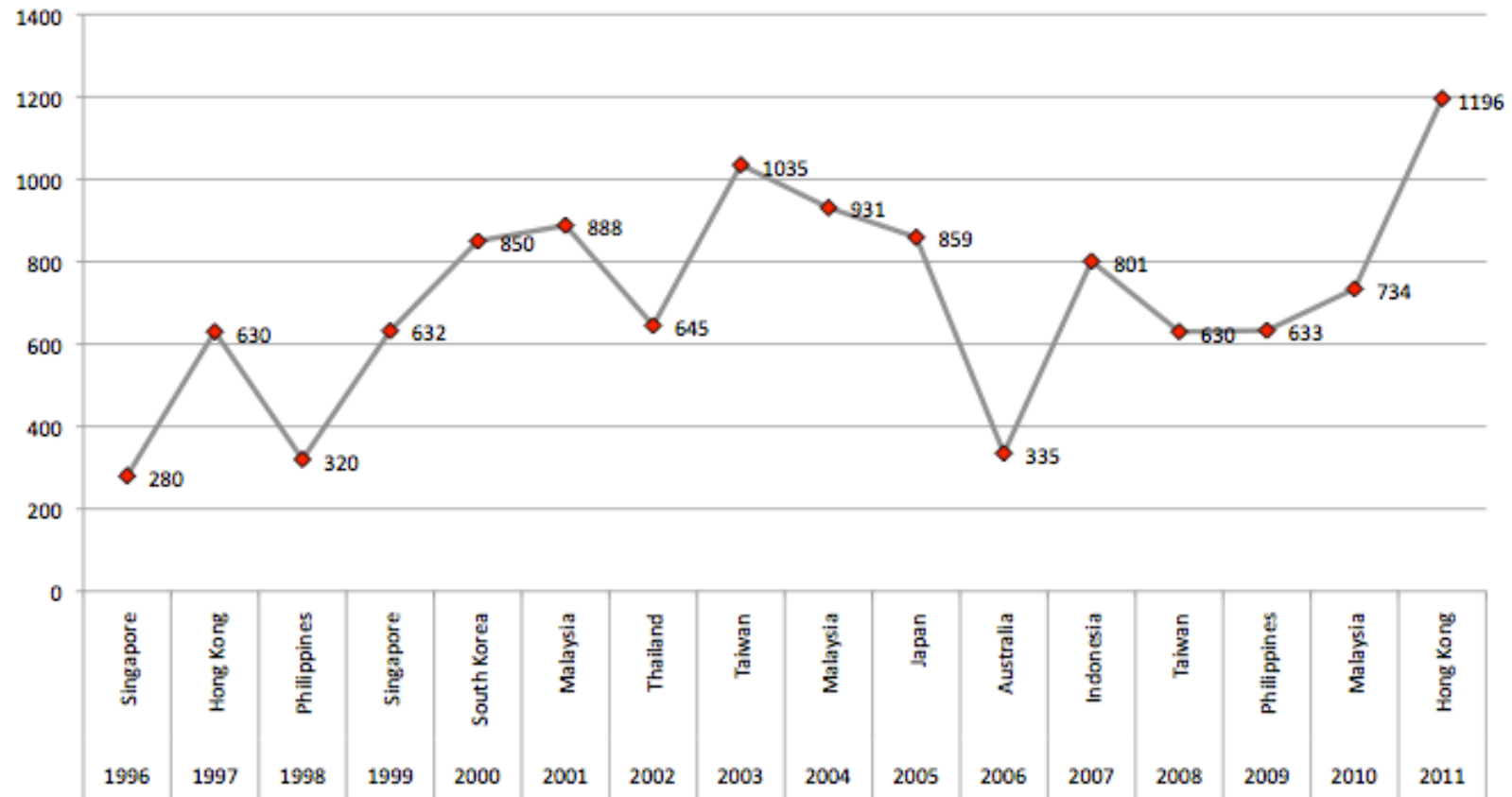
- Jointly Held with APAN for the first time
- Saw a successful collaboration that attracted a lot of interest from the Academic, Research & the Commercial Network Operators Communities
- Post Event survey revealed that majority supported the co-location.

APRICOT 2011

- Hosted by DotAsia & HK ISOC
- 1200 delegates from 60 Economies
- 34 Sponsors & 24 Supporting Organisations
- Host made a surplus of over US\$100K
- Successful & High Profile Event in HK

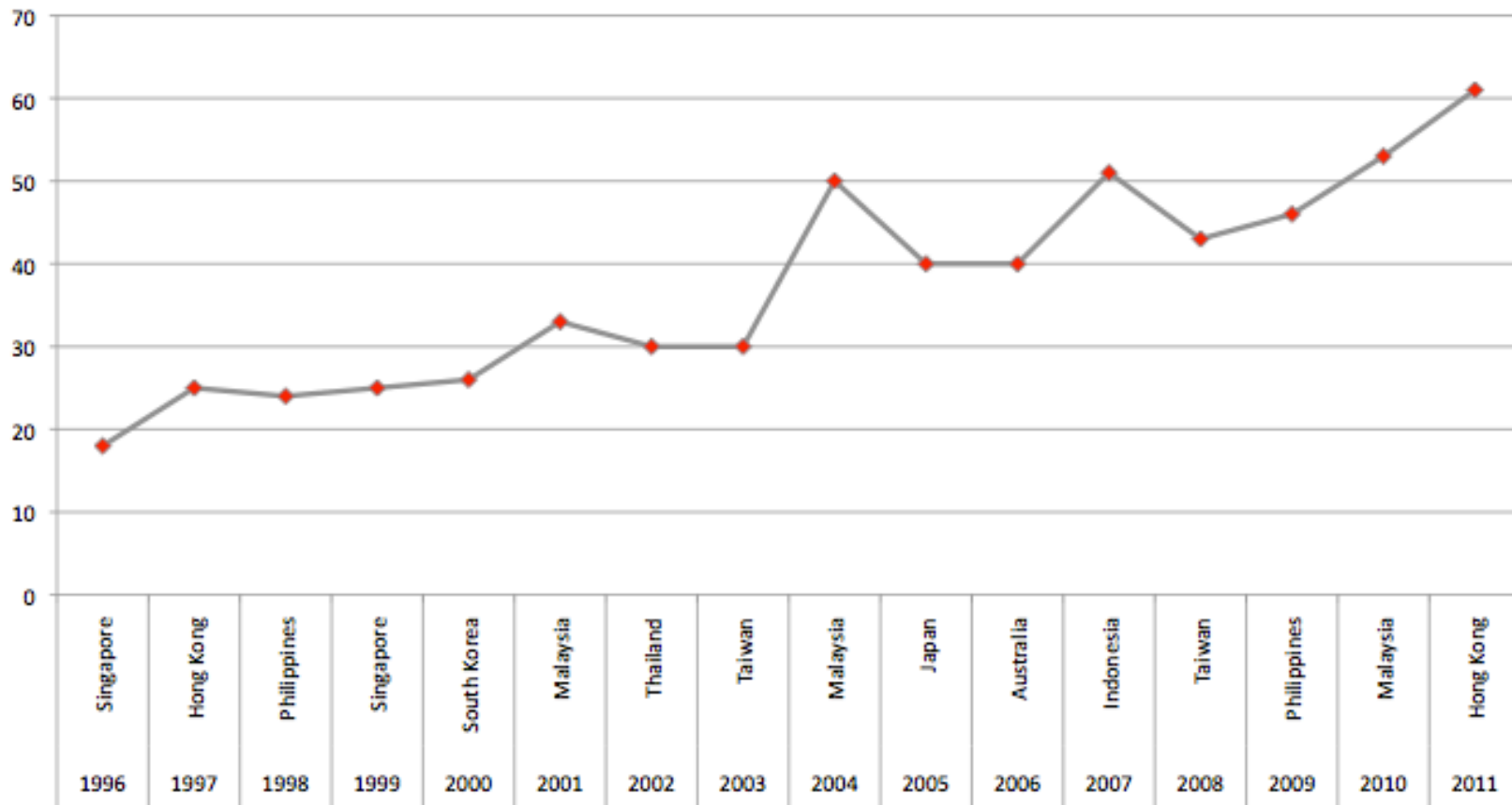
Total Attendees – Trend

APRICOT ATTENDANCE



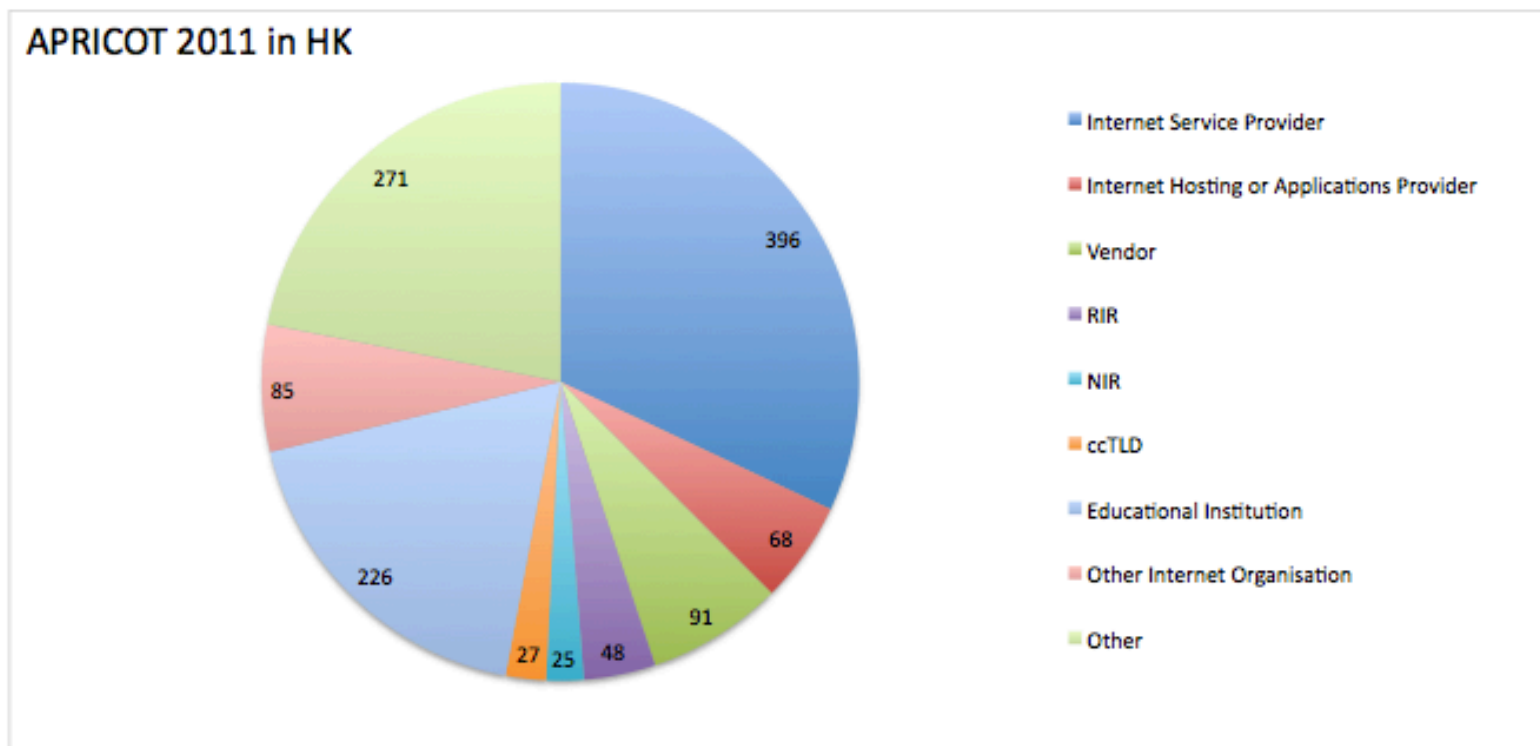
No of Economies – Trend

Demographics of Attendees

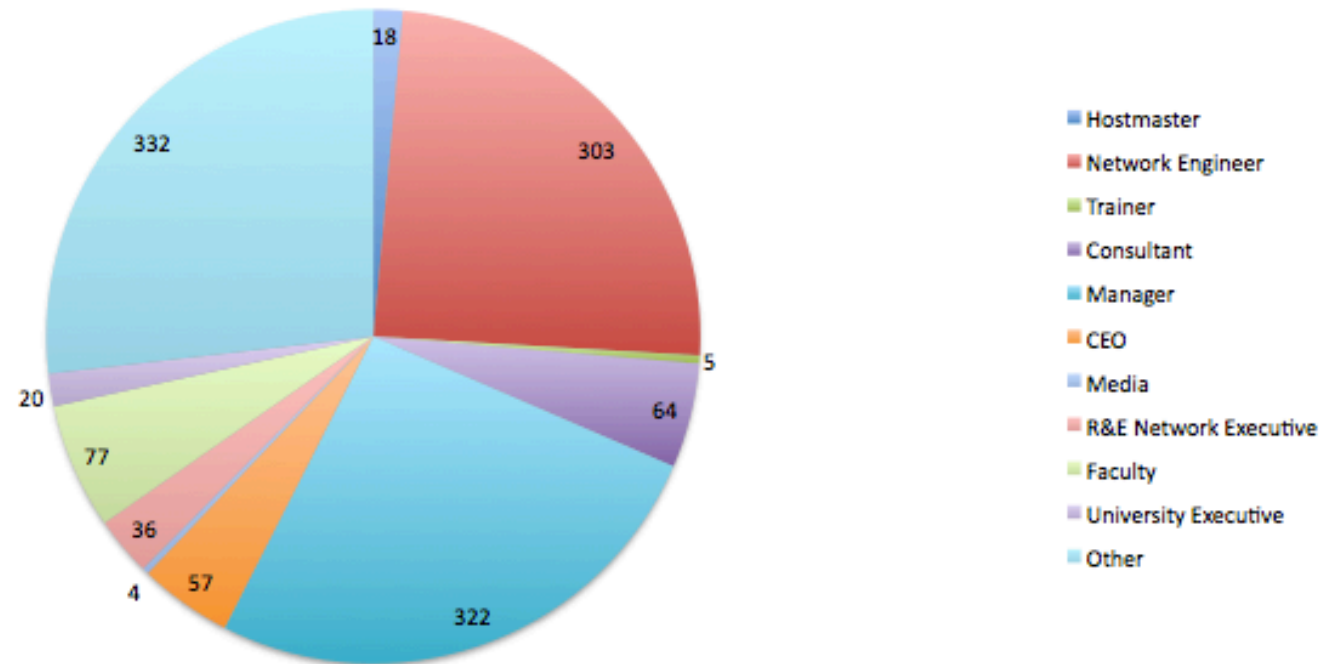
DEMOGRAPHICS :: BY INDUSTRY

APRICOT 2011 in HK



APRICOT 2012

- Held for the first time in South Asia
- New Delhi, India
 - February 21st to March 2nd 2012
 - Workshops: 21st – 25th February
 - Conference: 27th February – 2nd March
- Hosted by the ISP Association of India (ISPAI) co-hosted by the National Internet Exchange of India (NIXI)
- Hosts are leveraging APRICOT for many side events
 - Getting much attention – another benefit of hosting APRICOT

APRICOT 2012

- As of 25th February 2012, there are 674 registrations
 - 123 for workshops
 - Approximately 220 on-site so far
- APRICOT 2012 schedule includes:
 - 5 workshops
 - 12 tutorials
 - 9 specialist conference sessions
 - AP meetings (including APTLD, APIX, APstar, DotAsia)
 - A full APNIC programme
 - Opening/Closing Plenary and APOPS
 - Host led side events (students, IPv6, FutureInternet)

Future APRICOTs

- APRICOT 2013
 - Hosted by SGNIC in Singapore
 - 19th February – 1st March
- APRICOT 2014
 - Two bids received by 31st December 2011 deadline
 - Successful bid will be announced during APRICOT 2012 Closing Plenary
- APRICOT 2015
 - Deadline for bids is 31st December 2012
