Backgroud

- Empirically, infrastructure-development/population ratio-wise, AP lags behind Europe and North America
- Quite a number of APTLD Members have remained vulnerable and in need for realistic, scalable and actionable goals
- ccTLDs are still struggling to form a consolidated response to the challenge
- Coordination across the AP* orgs is at an early stage
 - due to the immaturity of APTLD

The Concept behind the Document

- All directions and action items should be:
 - Realistic;
 - Feasible;
 - Scalable;
 - Measurable;
 - Promoting collaboration between Members and other regional Internet industry organizations.

 - Preamble: recitals to emphasize the APTLD Community's perception, motivation and affirmation.
 - Main part: to list and highlight Directions and Commitments.
 - Concluding part: a short and powerful call for action.

Implementation Phase has started

- Brainstorming among APTLD members at the APTLD85 Session(21st Feb. 2024)
 - Discussion on how to act in 4 areas
 - Topic1: Focus is safeguarding the DNS, and encouraging uptake of robust cybersecurity and promoting universal acceptance
 - Topic2: Sharing knowledge and developing dedicated internet governance capacity for decision makers, public servants and next-gen leaders
 - Topic3: Advancement of new and emerging technologies to improve the DNS. Including conducting joint research and applied projects
 - Topic4: Effective collaboration through the multi-stakeholder system
- Further consideration will be done with APTLD members
