- Day to day project management responsibility for APRICOT conferences
 - Chairing APRICOT2011 Management Committee
- Operates the APRICOT Fellowship Programme
 - Includes seeking funding & fellowship finances, coordinating the selection process, managing the Fellows housing, programme & reimbursement
 - Guidance from Fellowship Committee Chair, Paul Wilson



Secretariat

- Manages the Administrative Function of the Programme Committee
 - Includes speaker management & administrative support function and supporting the PC at each meeting.
 - Guidance from Programme Committee Chairs, Jonathan Martin and Mark Tinka
- Soliciting International Sponsorship and partly managing the sponsors
 - In future will provide operational assistance to local host by helping to bill and collect from the Sponsors



Activities 2010

- CommunicAsia 2010
 - 15th 18th June 2010
 - APIA continues to participate in CommunicAsia in Singapore, promoting APRICOT and APIA
 - APIA transferred its sponsor benefit (a booth) to APNIC who participated



Activities 2010

- SANOG
 - APIA continues to support SANOG by promoting Infrastructure Development and Business in the Region and Industry
 - APIA endorsed the SANOGs held in Bangladesh and Bhutan
 - This is to encourage Internet development in the South Asian region
- AP*
 - APIA continues to support AP* by contributing US\$5K
 - AP* Retreat at APRICOT is also hosted by APIA



APRICOT Update

- APRICOT is the biggest event for APIA
 - Continues to be recognized as the main AP wide event on Internet related technologies
 - APRICOT structure allows the simple co-location of other AP Internet related events
 - 6th monthly APNIC meeting is major component
- Changes for the better:
 - Committees restructured and simplified
 - Website now designed and hosted by APNIC
 - Common content
 - Saves duplication of effort



APRICOT Update

- Management Committee
 - Led by the Secretariat
 - Limited to those who are actively involved in the organising of APRICOT
- Programme Committee
 - Open call for volunteers to APOPS and apnic-talk mailing lists
 - Responsible for tutorial and conference session content
- Fellowship Committee
 - Group of volunteers from across the industry



APRICOT 2010

- APRICOT 2010 was held in KL
 - 734 unique registrations
 - 31 Sponsors & Supporters
 - Delegates from 53 economies
 - Event easily met budget, and was a successful result for PIKOM



APRICOT 2011 & 31st APAN

- APRICOT 2011 and APAN 31 will be held jointly in Hong Kong
 - APRICOT 2011 will be held from 16th to 25th February 2011
 - 31st APAN Meeting will be held from 21st to 25th February 2011
- Jointly hosted by HK ISOC & DotAsia Organisation
- Preparation work is well under way



APRICOT 2011 & 31st APAN

- The joint event will have the following:
 - A Common Participation Fee not exceeding the amount of USD450.00
 - A Common Opening & Closing Plenary
 - Common Social & Networking Events
 - Common Internet Network System & Access
 - Shared conference sessions where appropriate

- Proposals for APRICOT 2013 (and future events) are very welcome
 - Expressions of interest already received
 - Submission deadline is 31st December 2010
- Tentative dates:
